Series Summary: Found: Perfectly Loved, Known & Seen

This special Mother's Day message, *Found: Perfectly Loved, Known & Seen*, invites the congregation to explore the profound truth of God's unwavering love, especially in times of brokenness, grief, and uncertainty. Using personal reflections, the story of the prophet Jeremiah, and foundational Scriptures, this message celebrates the assurance that God sees and knows each of us intimately, offering love and hope amid life's challenges.

Key Themes and Points:

1. God's Deep and Unconditional Love

This message begins with an invitation to view ourselves through God's eyes, not through our flaws, regrets, or what others may have said about us. Drawing on Ephesians 3:18-19, it reassures that we are fully known, cherished, and loved by God. The message speaks to the struggles many feel with self-worth and the longing to be seen and valued, affirming that in God, we are never invisible—our lives are poems written by the Creator himself (Ephesians 2:10).

2. The Comfort of God's Presence Amid Struggles

Reflecting on personal losses, the message emphasizes that God's love is a sustaining force in difficult times. Jeremiah's story is shared to illustrate that God's promise of hope (Jeremiah 29:11-14) often comes not when life is easy but during the hardest seasons. This reflects God's faithfulness and His presence with us in the "trenches," reminding us that His purpose is sure, even when we are in the middle of our battles.

3. Processing Grief and Finding Healing Through God's Love

A key aspect of this message is the process of healing from grief. The pastor introduces the RAIN acronym to help the congregation recognize, allow, invite, and nurture emotions, fostering a compassionate self-view. This approach encourages people to be honest with God about their pain, allowing His grace to penetrate their hearts deeply. Through this process, the message affirms that Jesus' love can heal, restore, and empower us to find freedom even amid sorrow.

4. Hope in Waiting and the Assurance of God's Plan

Using Psalm 16:8 and Jeremiah 17:7-8, the message calls believers to "stick with God"

and trust in His perfect timing. We are reminded that God is actively at work in every waiting season, shaping us for His purpose and filling us with hope beyond our current circumstances. God's promises are microchipped in our hearts, guiding us toward a future filled with His love and purpose.

Key Goal:

This message encourages every listener to see themselves through the lens of Jesus' love—a love that calls each person "Beloved," "Cherished," and "Known." Whether celebrating, grieving, or waiting for God's miracle, the congregation is invited to experience the healing power of being "found" by Jesus. This Mother's Day theme resonates for all who long to feel seen and known, reminding us that we are perfectly loved by the One who never fails to meet us where we are.
